



## House Wines

Bottle / 175ml / 250ml

### White

#### **Rio del Mar Sauvignon Blanc 2017, Chile 19 / 5.25 / 6.5**

Mineral style of Sauvignon which has clean citrus, greenage and gooseberry notes

#### **Pinot Grigio Terrazze della Luna 2017, Italy 19.95 / 5.5 / 6.5**

The quintessential Italian white that is a joy at any time of the day

### Red

#### **Shiraz/Mourvedre Meerestein 2018, South Africa 18 / 4.95 / 6.35**

Warm and spicy red with hot pepper notes on the finish behind the smooth dark red fruit. The Mourvedre adds lovely colour and a seductive fee

#### **Rio Del Mar Merlot 2017, Chile 19.95 / 5.5 / 6.75**

Bright, juicy, packed with plummy fruit, chocolate, damson and a lovely herbal note

### Rose

#### **Feather Falls Zinfandel Rose 2017, USA 19 / 5.25 / 6.5**

Just off dry but packed with summer red berry fruit and hints of water melon

### Sparkling

#### **Vino Spumante Prosecco, Italy (200ml) 6.95**

Delecate lemon notes and a refreshingly lively style



## White wines

### **Albarino Terra Asorei 2017, Spain 28.5**

A fresh and vibrant wine which is perfect with Scottish shellfish. Grapefruit and apple notes are perfectly balanced with lovely herbal spice notes.

### **Sauvignon/Roussanne 'Tendem' Bruno Andreu 2017, France 22**

Beautiful blend of zesty green sauvignon and richer more tropical Roussanne flavours.  
Balanced and delightful

### **Sauvignon Blanc Taringi 2018, New Zealand 25**

Richer style of Sauvignon with more stone fruit and passionfruit flavour behind the typical leafy green notes

### **Falerio Saladini Pilastrri 2018, Italy 23**

It's like a super charged Pinot Grigio! Zesty fresh green fruit, herbal notes and a lovely mineral quality on the finish

### **Chardonnay Reserva Casas del Bosque 2016, Chile 24**

Loads of tropical fruit, mango, melon and apple perfectly balanced with soft mellow oak notes which give the wine great texture

### **Macon Uchizy, Domaine Talmard 2017, France 31**

A sunny warm 100% Chardonnay with no oak aging. Lots of melon and rich lemon fruits and with a little hint of toffee

### **Sancerre BLANC Domaine Henry Natter 2017, France 36**

Natter's Sancerre has a little more weight and body which makes the wine a wonderful seafood companion. Fresh green notes and passionfruit on the finish



## Red wines

### **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Fratelli Barba 2017, Italy 26**

Full of soft, juicy red fruit. This is an easy-going Southern Italian red that is perfect on its own or matched with sausage and pork meats

### **Aglianico Janare 2016, Italy 23.5**

A brooding red from volcanic soils in Campania. Dark black fruit, earth aromas, leather and warm spice. Lovely wine

### **Pinot Noir Reserva Casa Silva 2017, Chile 25**

Superb wine that works well with game and venison. The fruit is soft and juicy and there are earthy notes followed by mocha and spice on the finish

### **Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva Casas del Bosque, 2016, Chile 24**

Ripe blackcurrant fruit and soft tannins, a wonderful wine for matching with red meats. Smoky on the palate with sweet oak notes and a velvet like finish

### **Portal d'Ouro 2016, Portugal 22**

Great value wine from the Douro. Warm spicy red fruit, dark cherry and blackcurrant notes along with liquorice

### **Rioja Reserva Gran Bohedal 2013, Spain 34**

Wonderful balance of silky dark cherry and damson fruit with complex oak flavours of spice, coconut and chocolate. Lovely family owned Bodegas

### **Triuno Malbec 2017, Argentina 26**

Smooth Malbec with velvet like tannins and a lovely texture. Dark berry flavours dominate but are perfectly balanced with mocha and coffee note

### **La Legende de Fonreud Lustrac-Medoc 2010, France 36**

Great value claret from the superb 2010 vintage. The tannins have fallen away to leave rich cassis, tobacco and smoke aromas. Perfect with steak.



## **Champagne / sparkling wine**

### **Prosecco Riflessi DOC, Italy 25**

A Prosecco with superb balance and finesse. Lemon sherbet flavours, elegant bubbles and lovely citrus and peach notes on the finish

### **Irroy Brut NV, France 48**

Irroy is owned by Taittinger but run as a separate Champagne house. The quality is excellent with perfect harmony and balance to the wine

### **Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV, France 60**

One of the great Champagne houses and the Brut Premier is consistently excellent. Extended aging and a high Pinot Noir content give the wine excellent finesse and power

## **Rose Wine**

### **Cinsault/Grenache 'Tendem' Bruno Andreu Rose 2017 20**

Provence in style with the red fruit character really coming through. Dry, fresh and packed with summer strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours

## **Port**

### **Fonseca Unfiltered LBV 2011**

Very refined LBV which benefits from being unfiltered hence a richer flavour of dark red and black fruit, treacle notes and dark chocolate (125ml) 6

### **Smith Woodhouse 10 Year Old Tawny Port**

Barrel aged Tawny style which is brilliant with chocolate, cheese and warm fires! (125ml )
